

# **COURSE ON CLINICAL EXAMINATION FOR POSTGRADUATES (COCEP -2014)**

***Dates: 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> March 2014***

***Venue: UCMS and GTB Hospital, Dilshad Garden, Delhi***

This programme is aimed to enrich the skills of clinical case presentation of the final year postgraduate students who will be appearing for their final examinations in the year 2014. We plan to conduct classroom postgraduate teaching sessions with a student presenting the case and the faculty analyzing the history, examination and discussion. We hope this programme would help you to learn the basics of clinical skills expected in the final year practical examination.

*The main features of this programme would include:*

- Discussion of the common clinical cases of postgraduate and DNB final practical exams
- Eminent faculty with years of postgraduate teaching experience would discuss the cases with students
- Students will get an opportunity to present the case to the faculty in an interactive classroom manner
- Sufficient time would be allotted for each case discussion so that all the queries related can be answered by the faculty
- We will try to include all the exam cases like tubercular meningitis, cerebral palsy, congenital heart disease, rheumatic heart disease, protein energy malnutrition, anaemia with hepatosplenomegaly, neonatal jaundice, preterm neonate etc.

Clinical cases would be discussed over a period of 2 days(**Session A**) as per the pattern of M.D/DNB examination. A total of 40 delegate students will be enrolled. Two students will be presenting each case in an interactive session with the teacher. They will be intimated a day prior to their presentation so that they can come to the ward and work up the case. **A new feature added in COCEP 2014 is a one day program (Session B) comprising of a four hour**

**sessionon OSCE which would specifically help DNB students before the examination.** This would be followed by another four hour session on “clinical vignettes on nutrition, cardiology, neurology and pulmonology. Case studies on hemophilia and Thalassemia would also be discussed on the same day. This programme is not a CME and no lectures will be taken by the faculty.

*Limited seats:* Registration will be closed with 40 students.

*Registration fee:* Rs 7,000 for session A & B (all 3 days), Rs.5500for sessionA (2days),Rs 2000 for session B alone (1 day)

*Accommodation:* Facility can be arranged subject to prior intimation (charges extra).
